PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

Welfare

Short term financial assistance for rent, room and board, utilities, transportation, and food

Communicable Disease

Disease monitoring, public-health follow-up and investigations, and community education

Weatherization Assistance

Assistance by weatherizing homes to conserve energy and reduce high utility costs

Foreign Travel/Adult Immunizations

Vaccinations to adults for routine immunizations and foreign travel

Comprehensive Energy Assistance

Utility assistance and repairs to home heating and cooling units

HIV/STD

Testing, some same-day results, exams, and treatment

Older Adult Services

Socializing opportunities and more independence for residents 60 and over

Early Intervention

Health evaluations; referrals to service providers for medical, psychological, and social needs; partner notification services

Home Loan Counseling Center

Homebuyer education, mortgage counseling, and down payment assistance

Immunizations/Well-Child

Routine immunizations for vaccine-preventable diseases; health checks and examinations

Dallas County Housing Agency

Helps residents rent decent, safe, and sanitary housing; financial assistance, counseling, and housing inspection services

Tuberculosis Elimination

Testing and treatment for tuberculosis; surveillance, public health follow-up, and investigations of reported/confirmed cases

Environmental Health

Day-care and restaurant inspections in contracted cities; mosquito monitoring and abatement

Public Health Preparedness

Works to prepares for, respond to, and recover from public health emergencies; community education and outreach
