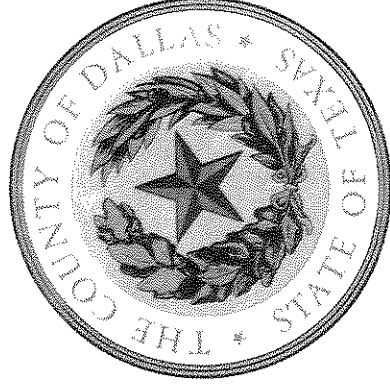


Resolution

BE IT REMEMBERED, at a regular meeting of the Commissioners Court of Dallas County, Texas, held on the 30th day of September, 2014, on a motion made by Dr. Theresa M. Daniel, Commissioner of District #1, and seconded by Mike Cantrell, Commissioner of District #2, the following Resolution was adopted:

- WHEREAS**, During the past 100 years, Dallas County, in fulfillment of the Smith-Lever Legislative Act of 1914, has provided Cooperative Extension Services for its citizens through dedicated collaboration with the Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service and the Prairie View A&M Cooperative Extension Program; and
- WHEREAS**, In the last year, the Dallas County office of Extension has presented over 2,050 programs, reaching over 76,000 citizens; and
- WHEREAS**, Today, the Dallas County Extension program has embarked upon establishing more progressive partnerships with more than twenty-six cities and municipalities in Dallas County, eighteen school districts in Dallas County, the Dallas County Community College District; the Chambers of Commerce in Dallas County; and
- WHEREAS**, The Dallas County Extension program has engaged over 1,000 volunteers throughout the county to provide community-based educational programs, with volunteers contributing over 120,000 hours, valued at over 2.6 million dollars; and
- WHEREAS**, Youth are our future leaders, Dallas County Extension has served over 36,000 young citizens through 4-H, nutrition education, and Junior Master Gardener Programs throughout Dallas County; and
- WHEREAS**, In addition to developing youth, Dallas County Extension provides research-based education, meeting their grand challenges: Advancing Agriculture, Expanding Horticulture, Protecting Natural Resources, Improving Health, Strengthening Families, and Growing Communities.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, that on behalf of the Dallas County Commissioners Court and the residents of Dallas County, who are the beneficiaries of the Extension programs, we congratulate the Dallas County Extension Service for over 100 years of outstanding service to the children and families of Dallas County.




