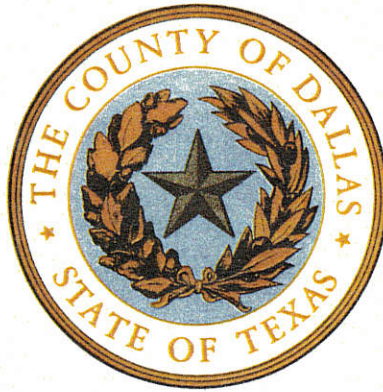


Resolution

BE IT REMEMBERED, at a regular meeting of the Commissioners Court of Dallas County, Texas, held on the 15th day of October 2019, on a motion made by Dr. Theresa M. Daniel, Commissioner District 1, and seconded by Commissioner John Wiley Price, Commissioner District 3, the following Resolution was adopted:

WHEREAS, The City of Mesquite proudly celebrates the 15th Anniversary of "Addressing Mesquite Day," an annual one-day event to help senior citizens, single parents, military veterans, and disabled homeowners with home repairs in Mesquite; and


WHEREAS, Addressing Mesquite Day began in 2005 as a partnership between the Mesquite Ministerial Alliance and the City of Mesquite as a way for church and community volunteers to give back to neighbors in need. Former Mayors, Mike Anderson and John Monaco, were instrumental in establishing Addressing Mesquite Day as one of the most successful volunteer programs and for creating an extensive network of volunteers who continue to give to this day; and

WHEREAS, Since the start of Addressing Mesquite Day, over 1,000 volunteers have given their time and talents to help more than 1,000 qualifying homeowners in Mesquite, including a member of this Commissioners' Court and staff. That number will continue to grow with each future Addressing Mesquite Day event; and






