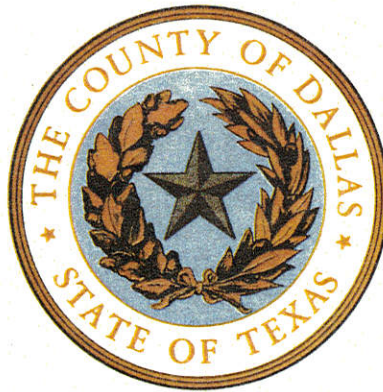

WHEREAS, Ms. Miller has continuously and diligently served Dallas County for 30 years and 9 months with honesty, integrity and a commitment to excellence.




