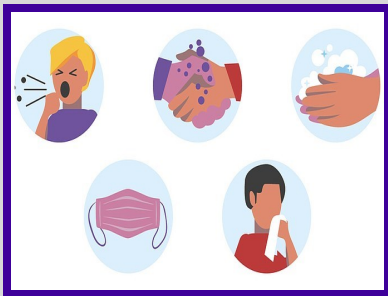
BACK-TO-SCHOOL

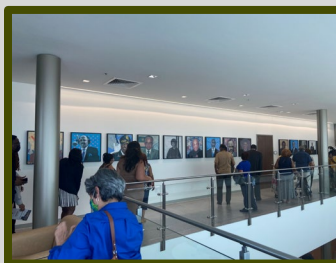
