




ORDER

Effective upon the date of this Order, in all cases seeking the appointment of a guardian or the determination of heirs, the County Clerk shall collect \$400.00 from the applicant as a deposit for the payment of a fee to an attorney ad litem. The attorney ad litem deposit shall be held by the County Clerk in an account suitable for the purpose and shall be disbursed pursuant to subsequent written court order. No case for which an attorney ad litem deposit is required will be heard by the Court until such deposit has been paid.
