

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
GUARDIAN MILEAGE REIMBURSEMENT

Effective as of the date of this Order in the Probate Courts of Dallas County, automobile mileage reimbursement for Guardians of the Person and/or Estate serving in guardianships pending in Dallas County probate courts for transportation of the Ward shall be at the “Charitable Rate”, existing at the time the mileage is incurred, as established by the United States Internal Revenue Service. An exception shall exist for transportation of the Ward for medical services. Automobile mileage reimbursement for Guardians of the Person serving in guardianships pending in Dallas County probate courts for transportation of the Ward for medical services shall be at the “Medical Rate”, existing at the time the mileage is incurred, as established by the United States Internal Revenue Service.


