

PARTY NAME CHANGE


Effective as of the date of this Order, in the Probate Courts of Dallas County, a change in the name of a party in the case shall be accomplished by **Motion and Order**. The Party seeking to change the name of a Party as it appears in the case shall file a **Motion** stating the legal basis for the change, (marriage of a party, divorce, or other legal basis for the change of name) together with certified copies of the documents which are the basis of the change (marriage license, decree of divorce, or court order changing the name). An **Order** granting the relief sought shall be filed with the Motion.

If the Court is satisfied with the evidence presented with the filing of the Motion, no hearing will be necessary and the Court will consider the matter by submission. If the Court desires a hearing on the matter, the Parties will be so notified.
