### **For Immediate Release: Dallas County Criminal District Attorney John Creuzot Announces Sweeping Justice Reform Policies**

**(Dallas, Texas)** – Dallas County Criminal District Attorney John Creuzot announces sweeping reform policies that will have a positive impact on the criminal justice system. The data-driven reform policies that I am implementing will help make our system more fair and just for everyone, without regard to race or financial standing in the community.

District Attorney Creuzot ran on a promise to bring about positive changes to the criminal justice system, and now, as the District Attorney, he has begun that transformation. His initiatives include reducing mass incarceration and saving taxpayer's money by using innovative approaches and alternatives rather than simply locking up people who have committed low-level offenses and are not a threat to the community. "The policies that I have embarked upon this year are a first and important step toward shifting priorities, treating people with fairness and dignity, while keeping our community safe," said District Attorney John Creuzot.

District Attorney Creuzot and his team have made impressive progress during the last 90 days in implementing new reform policies in the following areas:

- First-time misdemeanor marijuana possession
- THC possession
- Possession of trace amounts of drugs
- Drug possession cases without laboratory reports
- Criminal Trespass
- Theft of necessary items
- Driving while license invalid (DWLI)
- Misdemeanor pre-trial diversion expunctions
- Probation
- Bail reform
- Magistration
